In order to graduate from SMC with a degree in nursing, students should transfer to SMC after completing their first year at Holy Cross.

In their <u>first year at Holy Cross</u>, students should take the following courses at Saint Mary's College:

Spring Semester: BIO 142 and 142 L -- Anatomy & Physiology II (4cr) CHEM 118 (pre-req or co-req for CHEM 118 is Math 104, Linear Algebra, or higher) (5cr)

ADMISSION TO THE NURSING MAJOR

Criteria for acceptance into the nursing major at the end of the sophomore year include a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 and a minimum 2.8 cumulative grade point average in the science and nursing prerequisites **(in bold above)**. In the event that there are more qualified students than can be accommodated, students with the highest GPA in the science and nursing prerequisites will be admitted.

*Required supporting courses: MATH 114 (sophomore year), PSYC 156 or 157 (Psych 101 at Holy Cross), an approved Sociology course and one of the following: SW 235, PSYC 301, PSYC 305.
